The Japanese Language & Culture Program (JLCP) is a 9-day virtual program. The program will have synchronous and asynchronous instruction hours. Come study with us in one of the world's most exciting cities.

Program Length	Nine days (16 hours synchronous & 15 hours asynchronous)

Program Course	<p><Japanese Language Courses>: 13Hours -Students will first take a Japanese language placement test and then divided into different classes according to their levels. -10 hours of synchronous instruction, including live virtual activities with instructors (Monday - Friday, 4:20 - 5:50 pm JST) and 3 individual tutoring sessions.</p> <p><Lectures on Japanese Culture and Society>:3 Hours -3 hours of synchronous special lectures about Japanese culture and society, given in English.</p> <p><E-Learning for Japanese Language>:10 Hours -10 hours of asynchronous self-study with e-learning system. If students have any problems regarding the e-learning system, they can contact Japanese language instructors and administrative staff.</p> <p><Multi-Culture Environment>:5 Hours -Making friends with TMU students and having cultural exchange activities such as guided virtual tour of TMU Campus, Labs, and other attractions in Tokyo.</p>
Eligibility	The program is open to students who possess an elementary or an intermediate level of Japanese language ability and good academic records at their affiliated university.
Number of Students	Maximum 20 Students Minimum registration:12 students*
